- Ammunition:** Any safe ammunition supplied by the competitor. (Rule 3.17)
- Arms:** NRA Match Rifle, Rule 3.3 and 3.3.1 or Service Rifle, Rules 3.1, 3.1.1 and 3.1.2 Metallic Sights Only (.35 Caliber or smaller)
- Range Capacity:** Entries limited to the first 45 competitors, 3 relays, 15 firing positions. Advance entries appreciated but not required. Registration begins at 7:45a.m. on the day of the match.
- Squadding:** High Masters and Masters will be squadded on the same relay, not necessarily the first relay (rule 11.6.7). Other relays squadded in descending order of classification. Squadding will take place on the morning of the match. Late registrants will be squadded where space exists.
- Entry Fee:** Match fee is \$30.00 for club members, \$35.00 for non-members: Includes NRA fees and range fee. Fees for juniors are reduced by half. Range is located inside a Broward County Park. Admission fee at the gate is \$1.50 per person.

COURSE OF FIRE

All stages fired from 100 yards at NRA approved reduced targets.

Stage 1

SR-1 Target: 2 sighters, 20 shots standing in a total time of 22 minutes.

Stage 2

SR-1 Target: 2 sighters in 2 minutes. 2 strings of 10 shots each, 60 seconds each string, sitting or kneeling with a reload.

Stage 3

SR-21 target: 2 sighters in 2 minutes. 2 strings of 10 shots each, 70 seconds each string, prone with a reload.

Stage 4

MR-31 target: 2 sighters, 20 shots prone in a total time of 22 minutes.

Each stage preceded by a three (3) minute preparation period.

MATCH

Overall aggregate of stages 1 through 4. Current NRA Conventional Highpower Rifle rules will govern. All scores sent to the NRA.

AWARDS

Overall Winner

First Place: High Master, Master, Expert, Sharpshooter and Marksman.
2nd, 3rd, etc... Determined by number of competitors in the class.

Awards will be trophies. Three (3) competitor minimum are required to make a class.

MISCELANEOUS

Vending machines are available at the range for snacks and soft drinks. Water is also available on the range.

Matches will be fired from a covered firing point, regardless of mildly inclement weather. Severe weather may cause the Match Director to delay relays until the situation improves. All firing will be suspended if lightning warning systems activate.

NRA approved Empty Chamber Indicators will be required at these matches (Rule 3.21) *Available at the match for \$1.00 each*
